Kauri dieback has not been identified in this reserve but a number of trees are showing ill thrift and other infections. Most of the tracks in this reserve will be temporarily closed until the appropriate mitigation works have been completed	Full
Upper Harbour	Gills Road	There is kauri located along several of the tracks within this reserve. There is a large stand of trees in the northern corner of the park next to a track. Several kauri are showing ill thrift. Several of the tracks with kauri within the reserve will be closed to protect these kauri until mitigation works have been considered.	Partial

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Upper Harbour	Lady Phoenix Reserve	There is an informal walkway from Kittiwake Drive leading into bush. Located next to this informal track there is a number of healthy kauri. It is proposed that the Kittiwake Drive track entrance will be closed until mitigation measures have been considered.	Partial
Upper Harbour	Paremoremo Scenic Reserve	There are a number of kauri located along the two tracks entering the bush from Ridge Road and they continue down alongside the track ridges into the bush area. Since the kauri along this track are numerous and close to the tracks both of the Ridge Road tracks will be closed until mitigation works have been completed.	Partial
		The track off Brookdale Road is being upgraded in 2019 but will be restricted to an in and out track as the upper connecting tracks will be closed.	
Upper Harbour	Three Streams Reserve	Alongside the tracks are a number of healthy kauri especially in the north western area. Due to the large network of connecting tracks, and the need to protect kauri, all tracks will be closed temporarily while mitigation measures are completed. The internal roadways will remain open.	Partial
Rodney	Curry's Bush Reserve	There are number of smaller kauri along the western boundary of the park next to the two entry paths. There is also a small grove in centre of the park. Due to close proximity of the kauri trees to the two entrances and the track in the centre, we are proposing to close the park fully until mitigation measures have been completed.	Full
Rodney	Kowhai Park	The upper eastern track in this park has a number of quality kauri. There is one showing ill thrift and on a neighbouring property one large kauri has another infection. The lower western track has one large kauri. It is proposed that a small diversion around this tree will enable the lower track to remain open. The upper track is planned to be closed from the bridge near the Sandspit Road carpark entrance up to Westpark Glen Entrance to protect the heathy kauri until mitigation works are completed.	Partial

Rodney	Martins Bay Bush Area	This bush area is to the west and behind the Holiday Camp. In this park there is a substantial number of kauri alongside the track. The majority of the kauri is healthy except for some showing ill thrift and infections other than kauri dieback disease. Due to the close proximity of kauri dieback in this area to the tracks, all the tracks in this park are to be temporarily closed until mitigation measures have been completed to protect kauri.	Full
Rodney	McElroy Reserve	In this park there is a substantial number of kauri alongside the track. The majority of the kauri are healthy. There is some private land to the west with confirmed kauri dieback. Due to the close proximity of kauri dieback in this area, all the tracks in this park will be temporarily closed until mitigation options have been completed to protect kauri.	Full
Rodney	Omeru Scenic Reserve	In this park there are a substantial number of kauri alongside the track. The majority of the kauri are healthy except for some showing ill thrift and infections other than kauri dieback disease. Due to the close proximity of kauri to the tracks in this park, all tracks will be temporarily closed until mitigation measures have been completed to protect kauri.	Full
Howick	Point View Reserve	There are a number of healthy kauri within the reserve that are scattered around the fringe of the forest. There are several kauri growing next to tracks. It is proposed to close one track to the north of the reserve that comes into the reserve from the upper carpark off Caldwell's Road. Some temporary barriers will be installed around other kauri that are near to tracks to prevent public access to the feeding roots of the kauri.	Partial
Ōrākei	Dingle Dell Reserve	There are several young kauri around a junction of tracks near an entrance opposite 17 Fern Glen Road South. It is proposed that several of the tracks in this location are closed until mitigation works are completed. In the north of the reserve there is a number of kauri next to a small loop track. The loop track will be temporarily closed while mitigations measures are carried out. There is also a small grove opposite 4 Fern Glen Road North in an open grass area just off the roadside. It is proposed to temporarily close off this area until mitigation works are complete.	Partial

Waitākere Ranges	Seibel Scenic Reserve	There are several kauri in this reserve with one quality healthy kauri right on the track. The track will be temporarily closed until mitigation works have been completed to divert the track away from kauri.	Full
Waitākere Ranges	Bill Haresnape Walk	There are a number of kauri trees on the reserve infected with kauri dieback and there are several dead trees at the start of the track on Aydon Road. Some of the kauri have other infections including ill thrift. This track will be temporarily closed to restrict any further spread of kauri dieback to healthy trees while mitigation measures are considered and completed.	Full
Waitākere Ranges	Mahoe Walk	There are a number of kauri trees on the reserve are infected with kauri dieback and other infections including ill thrift. The narrow track on this park will be temporarily closed until mitigation measures are considered and completed.	Full
Waitākere Ranges	Opou Reserve	The track on this reserve links the end of Opou Road to French Bay Beach. There are a number of kauri on the side of the track showing ill thrift infection. This track will be temporarily closed until mitigation measures are complete and to prevent any further spread of kauri dieback.	Full
Waitākere Ranges	Paturoa Way	There are a number of kauri trees on the reserve and on neighbouring private land that are infected with kauri dieback, showing ill thrift and other infections. This track will be temporarily closed until mitigation measures are considered and completed and to restrict any further spread of kauri dieback.	Full
Waitākere Ranges	Rahui Kahika Reserve	There is a central track from Titirangi Road down to Castleford Street. There are sidetracks out to the south to Pendlebury Street and out to the north to Godley Road through an open grass area. In the park there are many informal tracks and a number of kauri trees next to the tracks. Several of them are showing symptoms of Kauri dieback. There is one with confirmed Kauri Dieback and several others that are currently healthy. Due to the presence of Kauri dieback in the park this track will be closed until mitigation works are complete to prevent the spread of kauri dieback.	Full

Waitākere Ranges	Titirangi War Memorial	This reserve has good quality and mostly healthy kauri that has not been infected with kauri dieback. It is proposed to temporarily close this reserve to protect the kauri until the mitigation works has been considered. The board walk access to the users of the rooms under the playcentre will be remain open.	Full
Waitākere Ranges	Okewa Reserve	There are several large kauri on the eastern boundary of the entrance to the reserve. The Okewa Reserve has a track that links the end of Okewa Road to a very steep trail down to the coast. This track will be temporarily closed until mitigation measures are complete.	Full
Waitākere Ranges	Tinopai Reserve	There is one main track within the reserve which links Tinopai Road and Pataroa Road. The track contains a number of healthy kauri. Mitigation works are required for the safety of these trees. It is proposed that the track is closed until mitigation works are complete.	Full
Waitākere Ranges	Wood Bay Reserve	There is one large kauri tree on this reserve near the short track that links the upper carpark to the beach. It is proposed to close the track temporarily until mitigation works are considered and completed.	Full
Waitākere Ranges	Arama Reserve	There is a track in Arama Reserve which links South Titirangi Road with the junction of Arama and Arapito Road. There is a number of kauri on the side of the track which places them at risk of infection. This track will be temporarily closed until mitigation measures are completed.	Full
Waitākere Ranges	Henderson Valley Scenic	There are several kauri trees on the track that follows the stream and leads to the waterhole which is 350m into the bush. It is proposed that the track is closed over winter and reopened in summer depending on ground conditions. It is proposed to follow this closure process until mitigation measures are completed. Waiheke	McKenzie Reserve	There is a stand of healthy kauri trees in the head of the valley towards the centre of the park. There is also a memorial kauri and several smaller trees on the main track that connects to the top track. It is proposed that the track in the centre of the park is closed temporarily until mitigation works are complete. Minor works are proposed around the memorial kauri tree and the other smaller kauri to protect their roots from public access.	Partial

Papakura	Kirks Bush	There are kauri located at the two main entry points of the park on Beach Road and Great South Road. The kauri on Great South Road may have kauri dieback. The kauri on Beach Road are currently healthy. There are unhealthy kauri on adjoining private land on Great South Road. Due to the close proximity of the kauri to the track and high possibly of infection both entrances to the park will be closed until mitigation works have been completed. The remaining tracks will be open as a circuit walk but access to the two roads will be restricted.	Partial
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
