
- > Recent user group discussions





What we heard...

× There is a funding gap for co-ordination and facilitation of conservation action limiting on-the-ground delivery.

Proposed solution...

Create an 'expressions of interest' funding process to provide more immediate support for community-embedded co-ordination and facilitation support for conservation projects.

Working with business

What we heard...

× The private sector wants to engage but there is **no framework** for them to do so. Currently, it's on an **ad-hoc** basis.

Proposed solution...

- > We want to co-design with you a voluntary 'green credential' system that:
 - supports a Pest Free Auckland
 - delivers market advantage
 - offers consumer choice
 - streamlines engagement with council

Regional Funding Strategy

What we heard...

- The time it takes to apply for grants outweighs the financial benefit
- There is no funding mechanism to support long-term agreements or operational costs
- × We're unlikely to reach Pest Free Auckland 2050 using current tools
- There is no collective approach and Council has no visibility of who's receiving grants nor what is achieved

Proposed solution...

> We want to develop a **Regional Funding Strategy** that also enables innovation
