


Figure 1: New Zealand mean performance compared to OECD average (2006-2012)



"We find that the people that actually support 1080 have a link, have a financial link to it," says Clyde Graf. "It's a big bureaucracy, so it's based on money more than anything. We are taking the cameras in so people can actually see the drop zone, where they won't go into . . . because nobody goes into these drop zones and actually looks around. That's all."

"We just go for a wander" says Steve Graf. "We just go looking around to see what we can find, because this stuff is meant to be so great."

■ The Graf Boys' new 1080 documentary, *The Killing Fields* – *Revelations at Dawn*, will have its inaugural screening on Friday, February 6, in Hokitika in front of an invited audience. Their first 1080 film, called *A Shadow of Doubt*, was released two years ago.

New Zealand First wants an immediate moratorium on the use of aerial 1080 poison till it can be banned.

Alternative strategies should be put in place ahead of a total ban on the use of the controversial poison, primary industries spokesman Richard Prosser said.

Research into alternatives to 1080 was not being given sufficient priority while its use was allowed to continue.

"It is a systemic ecotoxin which is banned in most of the rest of the world and for good reason.

"NZ First wants to see an end to the use of 1080 in NZ but there have to be alternative methods in place to deal with predator pests and TB vectors.

"We have to protect our native birds and our deer and cattle herds, and we believe an immediate moratorium will shake Government agencies out of their comfort zone a required sense of urgency in developing ground-based control methods and in seeking an alternative to 1080 where poison does have to be used.

"There are traps and bait stations which can be rolled out to target particular species right now over the great majority of the areas where aerial 1080 is applied at presen by-kill of the very native species they're intended to protect the way 1080 does.

"A ban on aerial 1080 is inevitable and an immediate moratorium will give the drive towards that goal the impetus it needs," Prosser said.

"We spend \$100 million a year on dropping 1080 from the sky at the moment and that could pay for an awful lot of boots on the ground and an urgent quest for alternativi further unnecessary delay."





# Move to add folic acid to bread goes backward


