Projects in Waitākere

Safety engineering at high-risk intersections 2018-19	
West Coast Road / Glenview Road	Speed table and speed limit changes, removal of left turn slip lane, removal of right turn filter, and improved pedestrian accessibility are proposed at this intersection in 2018/19
Piha Road / Scenic Drive	Temporary speed limit reduction to 50km/hr on Scenic Drive, flashing studs on all legs of the approach to the intersection, advance directional signage and intersection controls in 2018/19
Scenic Drive / Shaw Road	Signage and road markings to improve visibility and safety in 2018/19

West Coast Rd Urban Arterial Town Centre	Speed reduction (speed table and speed limit changes) and improved pedestrian accessibility are being investigated in 2018/19
Waitākere Road	Area-wide signage and road marking improvements across these routes to improve safety. Implemented in 2018/19
